**Bill Analysis**

SB 65 provides that state employees shall be entitled to 1 personal holiday per year. Employees may use the holiday on Good Friday, Juneteenth, Statehood Day, Indigenous Peoples' Day, Columbus Day, or the birthday of the employee. If the holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday in that year, and if any of such holidays fall on a Sunday, the succeeding Monday shall be a holiday in that year.
