**Bill Analysis**

SB 663 provides that persons holding a valid handgun license who completed 4 hours of weapon retention training certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) and demonstrated proficiency in handgun training and campus-specific active shooter training as determined by the appropriate law enforcement agency having jurisdiction in that public school district may be employed as security guards in a public school district. Such persons shall be required to obtain 4 hours of biannual training relating to CLEET weapon retention training as well as 4 hours of campus-specific active shooter training. Persons employed pursuant to the provisions of Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act shall be authorized to carry a firearm on a school campus.
