**Bill Analysis**

SB 669 provides that any person may apply for a driver license using an individual tax identification number. Such individuals shall not be provided voter registration services. The measure directs Service Oklahoma to quarterly transmit the list of individuals using this application process to the Secretary of the State Election Board. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall notify the secretary of any relevant county election board of any matches with registered voters based on the identifying information provided by Service Oklahoma. The county election board shall notify relevant authorities of any violation related to voting crimes or voter registration. Applicants using the tax identification number shall also pay an additional fee of \$50.00 in addition to other fees provided for in current law.
