Bill Analysis

SB 673 prohibits any person from occupying any campsite labeled as reserved by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department staff or by the park reservation system. Additionally, no person may use an area of a state park that requires payment of an entry fee for the person's recreational vehicle or travel trailer without having first paid the entry fee. Violators shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$50.00 for the first offense, \$100.00 for the second offense, and \$250.00 for the third and subsequent offenses. Monies collected from these fines shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund. No entry fee shall exceed \$8.00.
