**Bill Analysis**

SB 695 prohibits any person from bringing action against a firearm manufacturer for recovery of damages, punitive damages, restitution, fines, penalties, injunctive or declaratory relief, or other remedy based on the legal theory that the marketing or advertising of a firearm, firearm accessories, or ammunition was the cause of any personal injury, death, or property damage or caused or contributed to the creation or maintaining of a public nuisance.
