Bill Analysis

SB 710 authorizes school nurses or any person designated by the school district to administer an emergency opioid antagonist regardless of whether there is a prescription or standing order in place. An emergency opioid antagonist is defined as a drug including but not limited to naloxone that blocks the effects of opioids and that is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of an opioid overdose.
