Bill Analysis

SB 736 prohibits any peace officer, state employee, county employee, or municipal employee from enforcing, assisting in the enforcement of, or otherwise cooperating in the enforcement of a federal ban on firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition. Such persons are also prohibited from expending public funds relating to the enforcement of a federal ban on firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition. The measure prohibits the state from defunding any law enforcement office from declining to enforce a provision of law violating the 2nd Amendment of the Constitution of the United States nor shall it or any of its political subdivisions terminate or retaliate against any peace officer who refuses to obey or enforce any order which violates the 2nd Amendment.
