## **Bill Analysis**

SB 738 provides that an applicant for a license to provide alcohol or drug counseling services may qualify for the license if such an applicant is a certified alcohol and drug counselor and has completed at least 2 years of full-time work experience providing behavioral health services since obtaining such certification. Such experience shall be equal to 4,000 work hours, with at least 2,000 of those hours consisting of providing alcohol and drug counseling services to an individual or the individual's family.
