**Bill Analysis**

SB 755 modifies the membership of the Oklahoma Board of Nursing. It lowers from 6 to 3 the number of Registered Nurses, excluding Advanced Practice Registered Nurses, on the Board, one of whom must be appointed from a county with a population of less than 40,000. The measure provides that 1 member of the Board shall be an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse with no less than 5 years' experience. The measure provides that the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House shall appoint the public members of the board and 2 of the members shall be a healthcare profession other than nursing.
