Bill Analysis

SB 787 prohibits any physician or other healthcare professional from providing gender transition surgery to any person under 18 years of age. A person may bring an action against a physician or other healthcare professional who provided the surgery to the person and the surgery caused the person to not be able to enjoy the natural reproductivity functions of childbearing and rearing that the person would have enjoyed. There shall be no time limit for the commencement of an action brought under the provisions of this measure. The measure creates a rebuttable presumption that the plaintiff, based solely on his or her age, would be capable of bearing children if not for the gender transition surgery.
