Bill Analysis

SB 800 allows manufacturers to include goods with alcoholic beverages in packaging. Wholesalers and retailers are prohibited from selling the packages at a higher price than the alcoholic beverage alone. Retailers may offer discounts on retail packages for specific professions, including current or former members of the United States Armed Forces, but the discount cannot result in a retail price lower than a six percent markup. Retail spirits license holders are prohibited from pricing items higher online than the shelf price in their physical store, and spirits or wines can't be sold to any licensee at a price less than 15% above the wholesaler's cost, except for discontinued or closed-out products.

House Amendments

HA's to SB 800 completely replaces engrossed language with language described above and restores the title.
