**Bill Analysis**

SB 817 removes the requirement for inspectors to examine slaughtered meat provided the meat is slaughtered at a custom slaughtering facility. Such facilities shall carry out slaughter and preparation in accordance with state law. Meat from these facilities shall only be distributed to household consumers, restaurants, hotels, boarding houses, grocery stores, or other establishments located in this state.
