**Bill Analysis**

SB 871 adds the practice of falsely representing or presenting him or herself as an agent of a state agency or an affiliate of a state agency through advertisement or gives the false or misleading impression, of being affiliated with a state agency or an affiliate of a state agency through advertisement or publication.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 871 restores the title and modifies strikes language relating to publication. The stricken language is replaced with “gives the false or misleading impression, of being affiliated with a state agency or an affiliate of a state agency through advertisement or publication.”
