Bill Analysis

SB 886 requires each state agency to disclose the federal or state authority for any part of the agency operations upon a legislator's request. During each regular session of the Legislature, any member may request, by proper passage of a resolution introduced by either the Senate or the House of Representatives, a statement of legal authority for a specific facet of operations of the agency. The agency shall have 10 days to respond to the request upon receipt of the request. Any director or head of agency that does not submit a response pursuant to this section may be subject to removal.
