Bill Analysis

SB 910 authorizes the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to declare an open season to hunt and harvest velvet bucks during the time beginning on the Saturday morning prior to the last weekend of August to the Sunday evening of the last weekend of August in counties that can sustain an open season. An open season to hunt and harvest velvet bucks shall be declared by a Commission resolution not less than 10 days before the season is opened and be restricted to a limit 1 velvet buck per season. All velvet bucks shot, killed, wounded, taken, and harvested shall count against the licensee's annual bag limit for deer. The Commission shall set velvet buck licenses, permits, and/or stamps by rule. The Commission shall reward 90% of all velvet buck licenses, permits, and/or stamps to resident hunters of this state.
