**Bill Analysis**

SB 918 clarifies that the preemption applying to the regulation of firearms shall also apply to firearm and ammunition components. The measure provides that a person, municipality, agency, or political subdivision promulgating or enforcing any order, policy, ordinance, or regulation infringing on an individual's right relating to firearms preemptions may be ordered by the court to pay reasonable expenses to the aggrieved party if the party shows provides written notice of the unlawful policy or ordinance and allows the person, municipality, agency, or political subdivision 90 days to take corrective action.
