Bill Analysis

SB 92 directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to develop an electronic records system that shall submit the records containing the legal name, age, residence, citizenship information, and the electronic signature of each person who is a qualified elector or will be a qualified elector within the next 2 years to the Secretary. The Secretary shall forward the information to the relevant county election board which shall notify the future voter of the process to decline being registered as a voter and adopt a political party affiliation. Persons who do not decline to be registered within 21 days of the notification shall be registered to vote if the county election board determines that the person is a qualified elector and the person is not already registered to vote. No person shall receive a ballot or be added to the elector registration list until the end of the 21-day period.
