Bill Analysis

SB 920 specifies that provisions of law prohibiting a person from carrying a firearm on public property set aside by a county, city, town, public trust with a county, city or town as a beneficiary, or state governmental authority for an event shall not apply to events held on the fairgrounds and in buildings of the fairgrounds that are open to the general public during the Oklahoma State Fair or the Tulsa State Fair. Additionally, the measure authorizes the lawful carry of firearms on property owned by the federal, city, or municipal government. The measure adds public buildings used for a public meeting conducted under the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, facilities providing substance abuse or mental health services, certain sporting events, and the State Capitol building to the list of locations a person may not carry a firearm unless authorized by law. Public trusts and nonprofit entities may authorize a person to carry firearms on the premises owned by the entity.
