Bill Analysis

SB 928 prohibits public schools after the effective date from recognizing school employee organizations or professional educators' associations as collective bargaining units or collectively bargaining or entering into a collective bargaining unit. It clarifies that the bill's provisions do not prohibit school employees from forming organizations or associations to promote their interests. It prohibits a school from denying employment or retaliating against an individual because of his or her membership or non-membership in an organization or association. The measure modifies and repeals statutory provisions to remove references to collective bargaining by school employees.
