Bill Analysis

SB 94 requires school districts beginning in the 2023-2024 school year to conduct annual fitness assessments for students in grades three through twelve. The measure directs the State Department of Education to adopt an assessment instrument and requires school districts to provide the results of individual student performance on the assessment to the State Department of Education and the State Department of Health annually. The measure also requires districts to provide individual results to a student's parent or legal guardian. The State Department of Education and the State Department of Health are directed to analyze the performance results and identify any correlation with obesity, attendance, academic performance, disciplinary problems, and school meal programs. The measure allows the State Department of Education to contract with a third party to conduct the analysis. It directs the State Department of Education to submit an annual report to the Governor, who may establish a recognition program to acknowledge districts and schools that have most improved in their fitness assessments.
