**Bill Analysis**

SB 950 creates the Electronic Pull-Tab Device Act. The measure defines an electronic pull-tab device as an electronic device that displays an instant result from a pull-tab game by utilizing a touchscreen monitor and provides such devices to be authorized by the ABLE Commission. Such devices may include a bill acceptor, printer, and electromechanical buttons for activating the game and providing player input. For each electronic pull-tab device, there shall be located anywhere within the distributed pull-tab system, nonvolatile memory or its equivalent. An electronic pull-tab device shall not have any switches, jumpers, wire posts, or other means of manipulation that could affect the operation or outcome of a game. The measure prohibits such devices from having certain features.
