Bill Analysis

SB 999 requires any individual under the employ of the Internal Revenue Service to obtain a written license from the Oklahoma Tax Commission before accessing the financial information of any citizen of this state in his or her capacity as an agent or employee of the Internal Revenue Service. Such individuals must provide their primary residence and place of employment address. The Commission shall make available to the public on its website a list of agents and employees of the Internal Revenue Service that are licensed. The list shall exclude the residential address of the individuals named.
