Bill Analysis

SJR 15 calls for a Constitutional Convention to alter or propose a new state constitution. The measure provides that 68 delegates shall be chosen from the Legislature, 12 delegates shall be chosen by lot from the Executive agencies, 6 delegates shall be chosen by lot from Judicial Department, and 20 delegates shall be chosen by lot from the public. Delegates must be 21 years of age and be a qualified elector. Delegates would be paid for travel expenses for each day that the Convention meets; provided, the payments shall not be for more than 90 days. Any change in the Constitution or new Constitution must be presented for approval to state voters during the 2024 General Election.
