14 provide reasonable advance notice to the property owner before
conducting an in-person assessment of the property."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 20 1/2, insert the following:

16 "Inspection of real or personal property shall mean any use of
17 on-ground site inspections or use of publicly or commercially
18 available image overlays for purposes of valuation, data
collection, or any other purposes related to the duties of a
19 county assessor."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2821.1 of Title 68, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 County assessors shall inspect real or personal property by
17 using on-ground site inspections or by using publicly and
18 commercially available aerial image overlays for purposes of
19 valuation, data collection, or any other purposes related to the
20 duties of county assessors.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2024.
