L2	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 14-113.2, is

L 4	Section 14-113.2. A. The 1. A voter who receives an absentee
L5	ballot pursuant to Section 14-110.1 of this title shall be
L 6	responsible for marking the ballots <u>ballot</u> or directing a person
L7	chosen by the voter to mark the ballots <u>ballot</u> in accordance with
L8	the provisions of Section 7-123.3 of this title and as prescribed by
L 9	the Secretary of the State Election Board;
20	2. The voter or person chosen by the voter shall seal the
21	ballots ballot in the plain opaque envelope;
22	3. The voter shall fill out completely and sign the affidavit
23	or direct a person chosen by the voter to fill out completely and
24	sign the voter's name on the affidavit, such. The name and address

of residence of the person chosen by the voter shall be printed on the affidavit;

- 4. The signature to of the voter or person chosen by the voter shall be witnessed by two persons, who did not sign the affidavit on behalf of the voter, whose signature printed names, signatures, and address addresses of residence shall appear on the affidavit; and
- 5. The voter or person chosen by the voter shall seal the plain opaque envelope inside the envelope bearing the affidavit and return both envelopes, sealed inside the return envelope, by United States mail or by a private mail service, provided such service has delivery documentation, to the county election board in the same manner described in Section 14-108 of this title.
- B. No person, except members of absentee voting boards, shall witness the signature of more than five affidavits of persons who swear they are physically incapacitated and unable to vote in person at their precinct on election day. No person who is a candidate for an office on the ballot or who is related within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity to a candidate on the ballot may witness any absentee ballot affidavit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
