HB 2062 proposes amendment to 68 O.S. § 500.22 by extending the current sunset date of July 1, 2024, for the motor fuel discount allowed "eligible purchasers" until July 1, 2029. The discount is 1.6% for gasoline purchasers and 1.9% for diesel purchasers.¹
