**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2239 creates the Terry Peach North Canadian Watershed Restoration Act that establishes a program to manage and eradicate woody species in the North Canadian River Watershed, administered by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The total costs of watershed tests, controlled burns, staffing, purchasing of supplies and education would estimate at \$4,280,000. The Commission estimates there are approximately \$1 million in federal grants available, bringing the total cost of the impact to \$3,280,000.
