Fiscal Analysis

HB 2535 would modify the penalty for the display of material harmful to minors by a commercial establishment by providing for imprisonment for up to 1 year in the county jail and increases the potential fine to up to \$1,000 for a first offense. The penalty for subsequent offenses is increased to a felony, punishable by up to 5 years imprisonment and/or a fine up to \$5,000. The Department of Corrections cannot determine the impact of creating the new felony offense, but the Department does not anticipate any significant impact.
