Fiscal Analysis

HB 3071 prohibits the use of state revenues to provide benefits to illegal immigrants, excluding any costs related to law enforcement investigations of domestic violence, investigations of human trafficking, the transport or incarceration of an individual, or providing education to children from pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade. As written, this measure would apply to all state agencies. The potential cost savings to the state are undeterminable at this time, but no negative fiscal impact is anticipated.
