Fiscal Analysis

HB 3458 would expand the list of exceptions that allow the Oklahoma Tax Commission to share confidential tax records and be immune from liability for the disclosure. The measure would add district attorneys and the Attorney General to the list of individuals that can make a court order request for tax records to assist with the investigation and prosecution of felony drug trafficking or money laundering crimes. The measure would also allow OTC to share information with the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority. There is no anticipated fiscal impact.
