Fiscal Analysis

HB 3717 amends the type of identification required for persons appearing to vote. Requires SOK to develop a voter identification card that includes a photograph of the person to whom it is issued and provide them free of charge. The State Election Board anticipates a need of \$25,000 to implement the provisions of the bill. Service Oklahoma anticipates a cost to the agency of \$1.50 per license issued, but cannot provide an estimate for the amount that would need to be printed and issued as they are unable to determine the amount of persons who do not currently have a driver license or state identification card, but are registered to vote.
