Fiscal Analysis

SB 108 provides that any person convicted of possessing or selling multiple Schedule I or Schedule II substances for the fourth time within 10 years of the last conviction shall be guilty of a felony and subject to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 5 years and/or a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00. The measure also provides that the court may order a person convicted for the possession or sell of a dangerous controlled substance to complete a substance abuse assessment and evaluation and a diversion program. The Department of Corrections does not believe this will have a negative fiscal impact.
