**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1323 authorizes a retiring district attorney, assistant district attorney, or district attorney investigator to retain his or her sidearm, badge, and holster provided he or she completed a minimum handgun qualification course for court officials developed by the Council on Law Enforcement Education Training (CLEET) and is not otherwise disqualified from carrying a firearm. If a district attorney dies while holding the office, the succeeding district attorney may grant the sidearm, badge, and holster to the previous district attorney's next of kin. The District Attorneys Council anticipates a minimal fiscal impact, with their calculations for an average fiscal year being \$600.
