## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1709 will transfer the Office of Client Advocacy and the Long- Term Care Ombudsman program from DHS to OSDH. This will transfer 60 FTE between the agencies and require the \$3,053,000 in state appropriations for these programs to be moved from DHS to OSDH for a full fiscal year. OSDH will not require an additional space to house these transferred employees.
