PROPOSAL: New Law

Senate Bill 395 proposes to create the individual income tax checkoff for the benefit of Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster, effective for tax year 2024 and subsequent tax years. The proposal also creates the Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster Revolving Fund in the State Treasurer's office. All monies deposited into the fund may be budgeted and expended by the State Treasurer at the beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster for purposes of serving disaster survivors by providing free home repairs in this state.

If a taxpayer makes a donation in error, the taxpayer may file a refund claim within three years from the related tax return due date. The total amount of refund during any year is deducted from total donations received during the following year and deposited into the Income Tax Withholding Refund Account.
