**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 420 increases the time to file for a claim of injury or death from 1 year to 5 years as it relates to the Oklahoma Crime Victims Compensation Act. The maximum compensation paid to victims is increased from \$20,000.00 to \$40,000.00 for a single victim and from \$40,000.00 to \$80,000.00 for all victims that sustained economic injury in the commission of a particular crime. The calculations is based on the average amount of claims paid at the maximum(93.2) over the past 5 years multiplied by the maximum increase of \$40,000. The fiscal impact also estimates 5 suicides per year at the maximum payout of \$80,000.
