SB 585 proposes to amend 68 O.S. § 2358 relating to the income tax exemption of retirement benefits received from any component of the Armed Services by extending the exemption to surviving spouses.

Under current law, 100% of retirement benefits from any component of the Armed Services is exempt from Oklahoma income; this includes survivor benefits. Since this income is already exempt, there is no additional revenue impact.
