Fiscal Analysis

SB 673 would limit the ability of the Department to collect parking fees for normal cars, trucks, SUVs, etc., that enter parks and has the potential to impact revenue. It is difficult to say that new fines imposed would make up for lost revenue, as we do not know how much the fines would bring in or to what extent that law assessing said fines are being violated. The current revenue of parking passes is \$2,600,000. The penalty for early contract termination with the current parking program vendor is \$180,000.
