7 An Act relating to Medicaid reimbursement rate;  
8 providing an increase for Medicaid primary care  
9 providers; providing for noncodification; providing  
10 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall implement a ten percent  
15 (10%) reimbursement rate increase for all Medicaid primary care  
16 health care providers, with the exception of dentists.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
