NEW LAW 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-115 of Title 10, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 Α. As used in this act: 21 "Homeless encampment" means any temporary outdoor dwelling 22 or shelter used by individuals experiencing homelessness; and 23 2. "Municipality" means any incorporated city or town.

B. If any litigation results from a municipality's attempts to enforce ordinances relating to homeless encampments, that municipality, upon a majority vote of its governing body or other authorized officials, may make a written request delivered to the Office of the Attorney General for representation of the municipality's interests.

C. Upon receipt of the written request, the Attorney General or a designee of the Attorney General's choosing shall provide reasonable representation for the municipality in legal proceedings related to the enforcement of reasonable city ordinances governing homeless encampments.

- D. The representation may include providing legal counsel, appearing in court, filing legal documents, and participating in settlement negotiations.
- E. The Office of the Attorney General shall act in the municipality's best interests.
- F. The Office of the Attorney General shall submit an annual report to the Oklahoma Legislature summarizing the number of requests for representation received, the nature of cases, and the outcomes of the legal proceedings.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
