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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Professional
19	Sports Arena Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 897 of Title 62, unless there is
22	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall establish a
24	professional sports arena program to be administered in accordance

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with this section for the purpose of collection of tax dollars from out-of-state residents during the performance of professional basketball for which wages are earned while in Oklahoma, to be identified, collected, and allocated to a special revolving fund to be used only for the construction of a new arena, where those performances take place ensuring the collection of those taxes in future years.

- B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for the Oklahoma Tax Commission to be designated the "Professional Sports Arena Fund", to be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, shall accrue interest, and shall consist of all monies designated for deposit to the fund.
- C. The fund shall not consist of any taxes collected from wages other than from out-of-state residents during the performance of professional basketball for which wages are earned while in Oklahoma. The Commission shall not identify taxes to be allocated to the fund from wages from out-of-state residents paid to the state from other events, such as concerts, performances, or other professional sports.
- D. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall identify all taxes collected from the wages of out-of-state professional basketball players, coaches, staff, and teams. The Commission shall deposit in

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the fund all taxes collected from the wages of out-of-state professional basketball players, coaches, staff, and teams.

- E. The Department of Commerce shall develop policies and an application. The Department shall accept an application, after January 1, 2030, from the city in which a new arena is to be constructed, and upon review of the application, the Department shall certify to the Commission that the application has been approved and that the Commission shall grant the money in the fund for the approved application.
- F. No monies from the fund shall be used for anything other than the construction of a new arena. The fund shall not be utilized for any other reason except for an approved application by the Department submitted by the city for the construction of a new arena. Monies from the fund shall not be used for the maintenance or renovation of an existing arena.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
