The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 17 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the 18 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows: 19 Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the 20 initiative, and eight per centum percent (8%) of the legal voters of 21 each congressional district of this state shall have the right to 22 propose any legislative measure, and fifteen per centum twenty 23 percent (20%) of the legal voters of each congressional district of 24 this state shall have the right to propose amendments to the

1	Constitution by petition, and every such petition shall include the
2	full text of the measure so proposed. The second power is the
3	referendum, and it may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for
4	the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety),
5	either by petition signed by five per centum percent (5%) of the
6	legal voters or by the Legislature as other bills are enacted. The
7	ratio and per centum <u>percent</u> of legal voters hereinbefore stated
8	shall be based upon the total number of votes cast at the last
9	general election for the Office of Governor.
