14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution which
19	would add a new section to be designated as Section 2A:
20	A. As used in this section:
21	1. "Conception" means the fertilization of the ovum of a female
22	individual by the sperm of a male individual; and
23	2. "Personhood" means the state or fact of being a human being
24	with characteristics, feelings, and individualized DNA.

2	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
3	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
4	the following form:

7	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
8	This measure adds a new Section 2A to Article 2 of the Oklahoma
9	Constitution. The proposed Section 2A defines conception and
10	personhood. The proposed Section 2A states that personhood
11	begins at conception.

15	SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
