SENATE BILL 1010

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, which relates to violations of transportation of live cervidae; removing certain prohibition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-507. ~~A.~~ It shall be unlawful and a violation of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act for any person:

1. To refuse an inspection authorized by the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;

2. To commingle or integrate any native cervidae into a farmed cervidae herd;

3. To intentionally commingle or integrate any farmed cervidae with native cervidae;

4. To fail to maintain records as required by law;

5. To fail to maintain fencing as required by law;

1 6. To fail to pay any fee, fine, or penalty as required and
2 established pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;

3 7. To fail to comply with any State Board of Agriculture order;
4 or

5 8. To violate any provision of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae

7 ~~B. No person shall transport live cervidae into or through~~
8 ~~Oklahoma unless the cervidae originate from a state that allows~~
9 ~~transport of live cervidae from Oklahoma into or through that state.~~

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
