5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to long-term care; directing the  
7 State Department of Health to develop standards for  
8 and approve training programs for certification of  
9 intermediate care facilities for individuals with  
10 intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) care aides;  
11 requiring training programs to meet certain  
12 requirements; directing the Department to offer a  
13 training program that meets certain standards;  
14 authorizing certain contract and fees; providing for  
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1950.3a of Title 63, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The State Department of Health shall:

21 1. Develop standards and approve training programs for  
22 certification of intermediate care facilities for individuals with  
23 intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) care aides. Each training  
24 program shall meet all requirements prescribed by rules promulgated  
25 by the State Commissioner of Health; and

26 2. Offer a training program for certification of ICF/IID care  
27 aides that meets the standards prescribed under paragraph 1 of this

1 section. The Department may contract with a third-party vendor to  
2 provide the training program. The Department may charge reasonable  
3 fees for the training program and for evaluation of ICF/IID care  
4 aides.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
