BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1950.3a of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall:

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- 1. Develop standards and approve training programs for certification of intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) care aides. Each training program shall meet all requirements prescribed by rules promulgated by the State Commissioner of Health; and
- 2. Offer a training program for certification of ICF/IID care aides that meets the standards prescribed under paragraph 1 of this

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    section. The Department may contract with a third-party vendor to
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   provide the training program. The Department may charge reasonable
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    fees for the training program and for evaluation of ICF/IID care
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    aides.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
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
