21	days or their sentence has been discharged, including			
22	any term of incarceration, parole or supervision, or

5 2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated 6 person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the 7 Oklahoma Statutes shall be ineligible to register to vote. When 8 such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer 9 incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered 10 voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any 11 person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term 12 is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes 13 from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging 14 the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such person from 15 being eligible to register to vote.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
