17	A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana
18	flower, trim, shake, kief, product, or other flower-based product
19	not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by licensed medical
20	marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial
21	growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only in pre-
22	packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than one-half (1/2)
23	of one (1) gram to not more than three (3) ounces.
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1 B. Nonopaque materials may be used when packaging medical 2 marijuana flower provided all other packaging and labeling 3 requirements for medical marijuana products sold in this state are 4 met and it is placed in an opaque container before leaving a 5 licensed medical marijuana dispensary. 6 The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be С. 7 allowed pursuant to Section 421 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma 8 Statutes. 9 SECTION 2.
