SENATE BILL 1963

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; authorizing advertisement of certain products; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; adding donkey milk to certain exceptions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-422 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person who engages in the on-farm retail sale of donkey milk or donkey milk products may advertise such donkey milk or donkey milk products.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not be construed to:

1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where the milk is produced;

1 2. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat milk
2 or donkey milk; and

3 3. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
4 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

5 B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
6 or donkey milk are those sales where the average monthly number of
7 gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100).

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
