SENATE BILL 440 By: Garvin

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AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; directing promulgation of rules to impose limits on tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) potency of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products; setting certain limits on potency; prohibiting licensed medical marijuana dispensary from selling medical marijuana or medical marijuana product that exceeds potency limits; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.18a of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana

Authority shall promulgate rules to limit the tetrahydrocannabinol

(THC) potency of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products

sold in medical marijuana dispensaries. The limits imposed by such

rules shall be at the discretion of the Executive Director, provided

that the limits do not exceed:

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1 Thirty percent (30%) delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol potency 2 for medical marijuana and sixty percent (60%) delta-9 3 tetrahydrocannabinol potency for medical marijuana products; 4 2. Two percent (2%) delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol potency for 5 medical marijuana and medical marijuana products; and 6 3. Zero percent (0%) potency of delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol 7 and all other isomers, precursors, and other variations of 8 tetrahydrocannabinol for medical marijuana and medical marijuana 9 products. 10 A licensed medical marijuana dispensary shall not sell any 11 medical marijuana or medical marijuana product that exceeds the THC 12 potency limits imposed under this section. 13 SECTION 2.
